



# Conflict Mineral Policy Statement

The Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act invoked section 1502 in 2010 with a goal of aiding the humanitarian effort to reduce the violence in the conflict region of the Democratic Republic of the Congo and surrounding countries. Although this directive does not apply to MadgeTech, Inc. (as a privately held company), we are committed to being a responsible partner to our global community.

MadgeTech, Inc. does not knowingly purchase raw material or components containing tin, tungsten, tantalum or gold that originated from this “Conflict Region”, unless they originate from mines or smelters that are certified, “conflict free”.

Further, we require our suppliers to conform to this policy and conduct periodic reviews of them to ensure compliance to the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act.
