



## Policy on Electrical Equipment Hazardous Substances

MadgeTech, Inc. recognizes the potential impact certain chemicals used in the electrical and electronic equipment (EEE) industry may have on the environment. We seek to comply with all laws that protect the environment. The EU Directive 2011/65/EU (RoHS) was established to place specific restrictions on products entering the European Union Member States.

June 8, 2011 RoHS2 was released extending the restrictions of the original directive on additional EEE products. Monitoring and control instruments were added at this time, with an effective compliance date of July 2017. Many of MadgeTech's products fall under this scope.

Under RoHS 2 the regulations apply to products released to market after June 2017 or current products offerings with sufficient modifications. At this time all MadgeTech product offerings meet the requirements of this directives based on the date released to market.

We have pro-actively screened most of our componentry to determine if any such hazardous substances exist. We will continue this effort and seek to replace any components if they are found to contain such substances.

As we make major modifications to products and release new products to market, we will assure they meet the requirements of RoHS2.
